

Events Child Care Caregiver

Job Description

SUMMARY / PURPOSE:

A Caregiver serves in the nursery or preschool during ministry events at College Park Church. He/she is responsible for the safety and well-being of the children in his/her care. The caregiver's interaction with the children should be a reflection of Christ and His love for them. Events Child Care Caregivers serve as part of the Children's Ministries team which strives to ignite a passion to follow Jesus in the lives of children and their families.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- Engage with the children physically and emotionally by playing, reading, and talking with them
- Assist with caregiving tasks, such as diaper changes, bathroom, meals, snacks
- Collaborate with other caregivers to soothe children with separation anxiety
- Assist the classroom teacher during Bible lessons, crafts, and prayer
- Provide close supervision at playgrounds, making safety the priority
- Assist with classroom clean-up following each event
